Pregnant Uterus Umbilical Artery Doppler PROC 2015-005

Umbilical Artery Doppler may be indicated when ONE of the following is present:

1	Pre-eclampsia or eclampsia
2	Fetal growth restriction
3	Multi-fetal gestation
4	Placental dysfunction
