Echoencephalogram Procedure 2015-008

Echoencephalogram is an ultrasound study of the head, primarily performed on children. An echoencephalogram may be indicated when any ONE of the following is present:

1	Microcephaly (smaller than normal head size) is documented.
2	Macrocephaly (larger than normal head size) is documented.
3	Any one of the following is suspected or requires imaging to diagnose or follow up: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • congenital malformation • intracranial pathology • hemorrhage • increased intracranial pressure • hydrocephalus (accumulation of an excessive amount of cerebrospinal fluid) • abnormal ventricular size • abnormal fluid collection • neoplasm, mass, or tumor • structural abnormality
